






Conservancy


































THE HERMANN PARK RAILROAD TAKES A TWO-MILE, 18 MINUTE JOURNEY AROUND HERMANN PARK. THE TRAIN DEPARTS FROM KINDER STATION EVERY 25 - 30 MINUTES. THERE ARE THREE STOPS ALONG HERMANN PARK RAILROAD TO ALLOW TRAIN RIDERS TO GET ON OR OFF AT VARIOUS POINTS OF INTEREST IN THE PARK. STOPS INCLUDE THE M. D. ANDERSON TRAIN STATION ACROSS FROM THE HOUSTON MUSEUM OF NATURAL SCIENCE, THE SUNSET STOP WITH ACCESS TO METRORAIL AND RICE UNIVERSITY.
